Overview:

MMFA created our first field of interest (FOI) grantmaking fund in March 2019 and began making grants in February 2020.

In 2023 MMFA began putting a portion of our income into the grantmaking program.

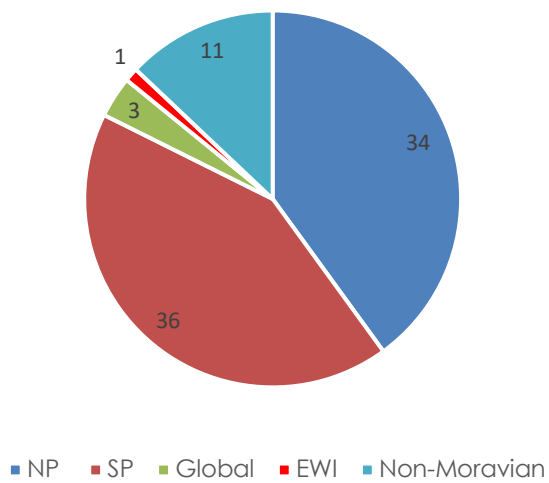

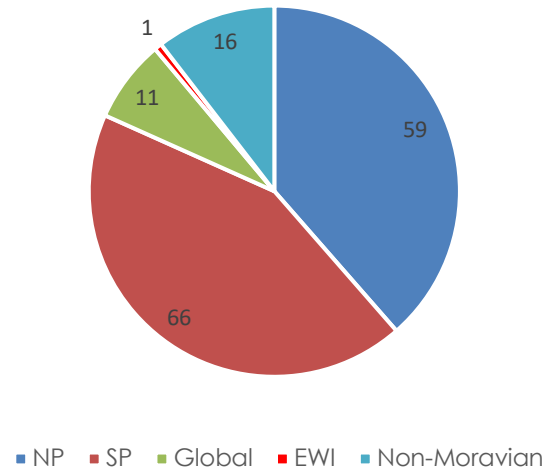

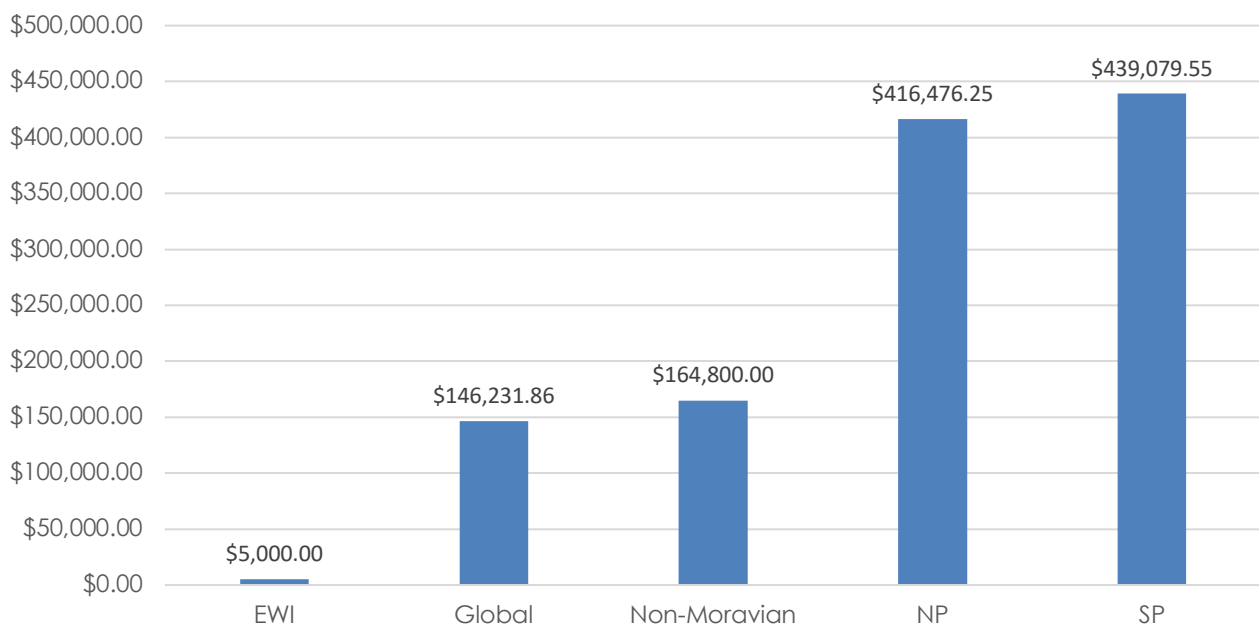
Grantee Organizations by Province



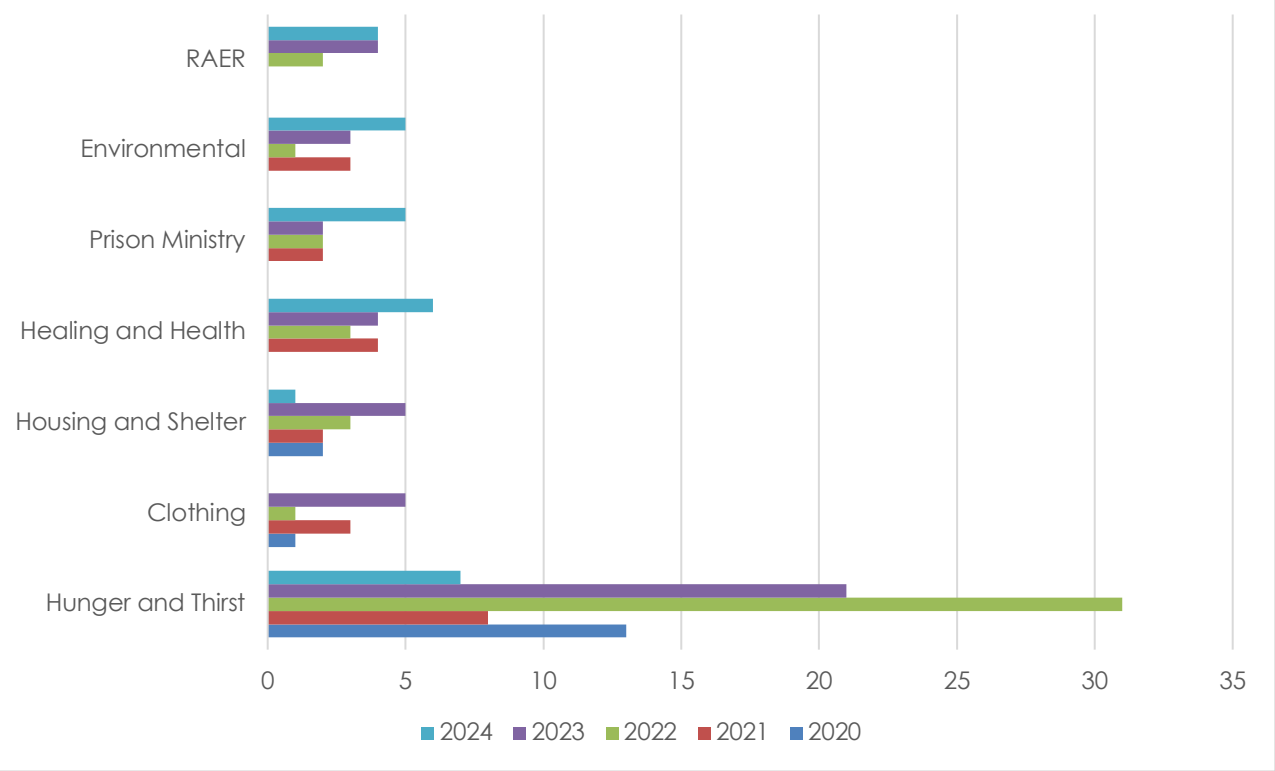
Grants per Province



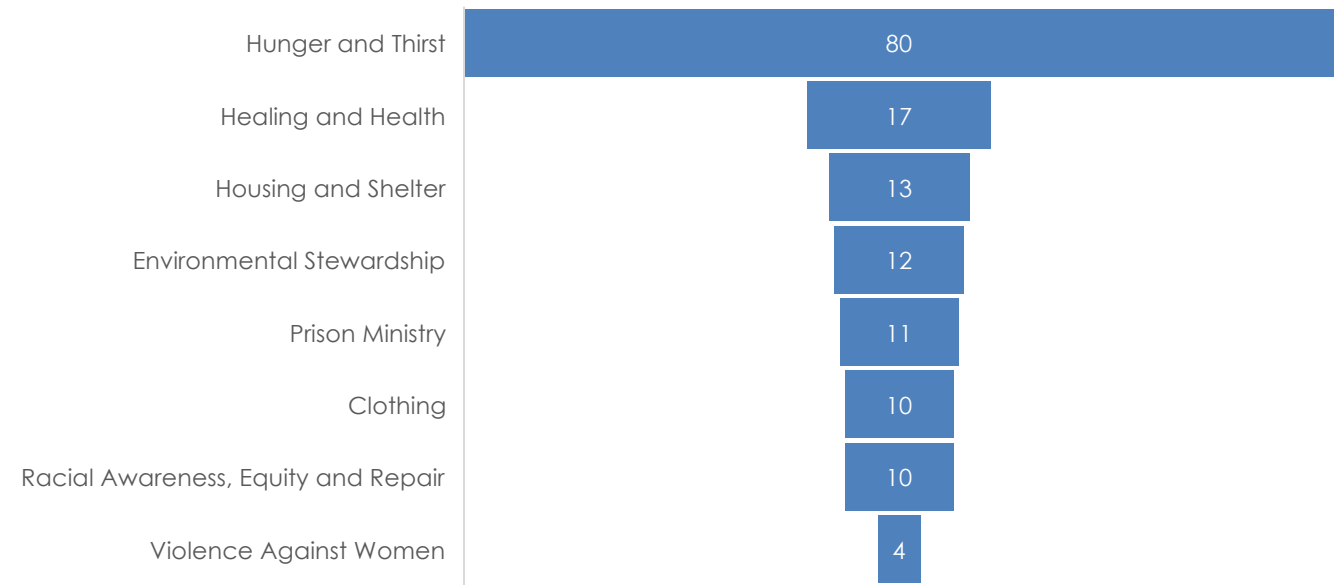
Total Amounts Granted by Province



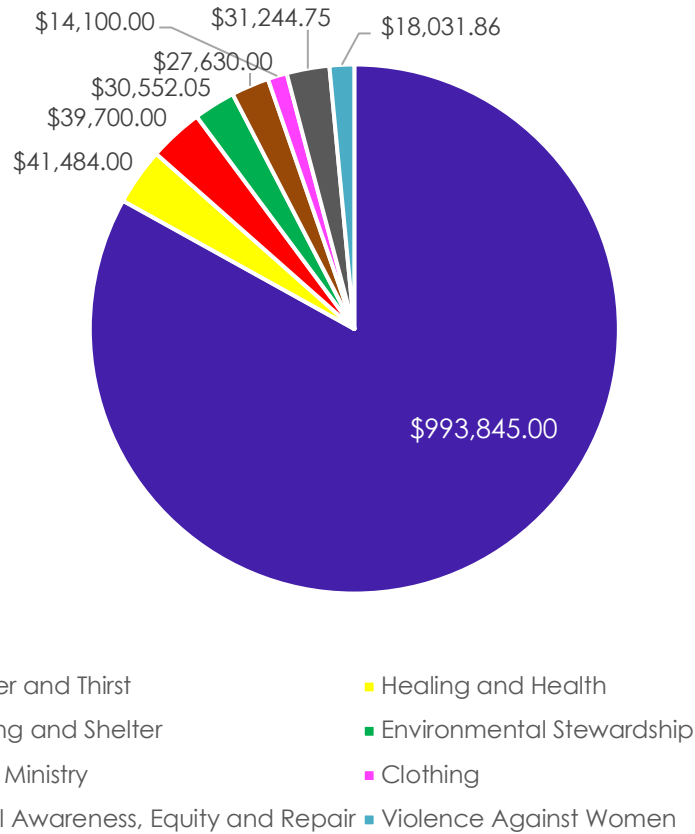
Number of Awards per FOI Fund, 2020-2024

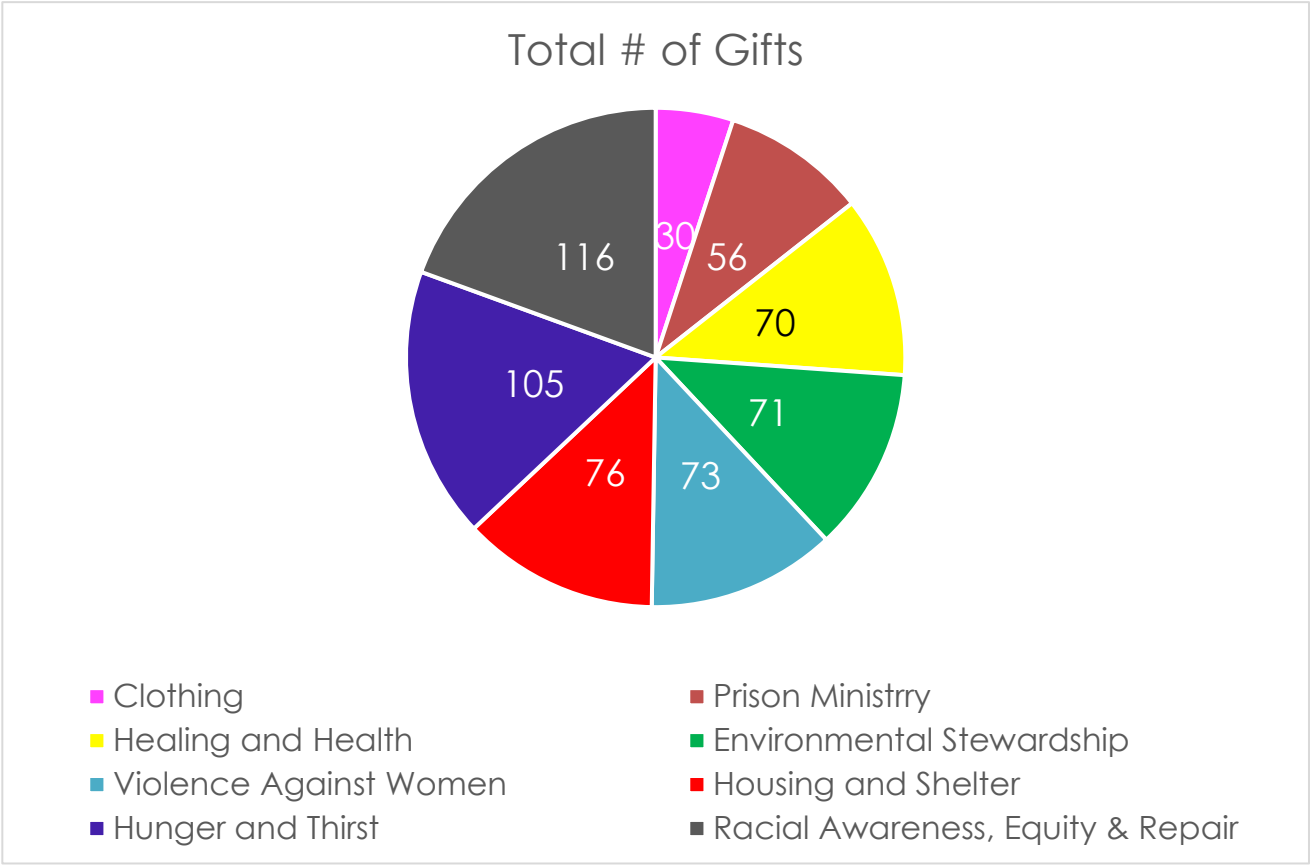
